You are entitled to **health insurance** during your stay, which gives you access to free healthcare and social services.

HEALTH INSURANCE

The *Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec* (RAMQ) covers medical services for all registered persons. Here are the three steps of the registration process.

CALL THE RAMQ AT 1(855)232-7267

- Call 1 (855) 232-7267 to speak to an agent: this phone line is for Ukrainian nationals only
- An agent will ask you your last and first name, date of birth, postal address, and telephone number
- You will then receive a registration form by post at the address provided

PLEASE NOTE: The service is in French or English only. Ask for help from a trusted person if you do not understand either of these two languages: they can open a file for you. You <u>cannot</u> submit your application online.

COMPLETE AND MAIL THE REGISTRATION FORM

Once received, fill in the registration form: if you have changed your postal address, cross out the old address and indicate your new address next to it

Insert a photocopy of the document issued by the Canadian immigration authorities (and Quebec authorities for permanent residents), either:

- Study permit
- Confirmation of permanent residence and
- Work permit
- Quebec selection certificate (CSQ)

• Visitor visa

Once you have gathered the documents, place them in the pre-addressed return envelope with a postage stamp and post.

RECEIVE YOUR RAMQ CARD

Once your request has been processed, you will receive your RAMQ card by mail.

PLEASE NOTE: It is essential to inform the RAMQ of any postal address change to receive your card. Call 1 (855) 232-7267. If a third party makes the call for you, you must complete the Power of Attorney form to authorize them to represent you: https://www.ramq.gouv.qc.ca/fr/media/2881.

HEALTH CHECK-UP

While waiting for your RAMQ card, you can make an appointment for a health check-up for yourself and your family. *Be careful not to confuse it with the Medical Diagnostic Test required by the Government of Canada.* The health check-up consists of:

WHAT IS IT?

It is a **free** meeting with health professionals to check your health state and needs and refer you to the appropriate services.

This first meeting will **facilitate your access** to health and social services during your stay in Quebec.

WHO DOES THE HEALTH CHECK-UP?

A **nursing professional** will assess your state of physical health:

- Complete examination (weight, height, blood pressure, illnesses, injuries, etc.)
- Vaccination update
- Screening tests
- Renewal of prescriptions

If necessary, they can refer you to a physician.

The healthcare and social services are provided in French and English. If you wish, you

A social work professional will assess your well-being:

• Support and resources in Quebec

- Settlement process
- Questions, concerns

may request an **interpreter** to be present during the meeting.

It is highly recommended to undergo this health check-up.
